Welcome to AP Human Geography!

You've been chosen for this class because you have proven that you're ready for college level work. In your summer assignment, you will demonstrate your skills in advanced reading comprehension, informative writing, and analysis.

The topic was pulled from the 8th grade curriculum for social studies: Japanese Internment during World War 2. It was chosen so that you can begin applying college level skills in a familiar context.

Guidelines:

1. In Part 1, you will read articles about the Japanese American internment. At the end of each article, you will answer questions about the article. Write in complete sentences. In part 2, on the last page of this packet, you will label a world map with information related to the articles.
2. Annotate everything. Underline, highlight, and write notes on the text, images, maps, directions and questions. You will need to demonstrate that you can follow directions well, so make sure you read them carefully. We will be using these documents in class as well, and annotation will make the documents easier to refer to in class.
3. Be clear and meaningful. Identify specific people, groups, places, time periods, and other important factors. If you write a sentence such as "They did that because it was the thing they needed", I cannot tell what you mean because I don't know who "they" are, what "it" is, or any other specific thing in the sentence. Additionally, make sure you only discuss facts that are relevant and support your answer directly.
4. Focus on analysis. As you examine the sources provided, look for underlying issues, connections, and patterns.
5. Write in your own words.
